Methodology: The sample size for the survey is 1,144 likely Democratic caucus goers in Colorado taken from a listed sample of registered democrats who participated in the past primary elections and new registrants. The margin of error is +/- 2.98\%. 864 interviews were completed using automated telephone technology and 280 were conducted using mobile phones. All interviews were conducted February 16-17, 2016 by TPC Research. The total percentages for responses may not equal $100 \%$ due to rounding.
