

Many Millennials unfamiliar with Communist leaders








Among those familiar, at least a quarter have favorable impressions of Guevara, Marx and Lenin


Among Millennials Familiar with Each




Additionally, the impact of communism is underestimated

• Despite recognizing that Joseph Stalin caused more deaths than George W. Bush, the public grossly underestimates the death toll (overall and versus Hitler).


More people were killed under George W. Bush's presidency than Joseph Stalin's leadership.

Number Killed by Communism







Gen Z and Millennials are more likely than their older counterparts to incorrectly identify the number killed by communism.





Younger Americans Have Sharply Different Views of Communism and Socialism than Older Americans


Overall, Americans recognize Communism was and still is a problem


Q15 Which of the following is closest to your view?

But, younger generations don't realize the lasting problem of communism






Millennials are most likely to view socialism and communism favorably






Nearly two-thirds agree with Marxist philosophy






Appeal of socialist candidates among younger generations continues

Intent to Vote for Candidate who Self-describes as...




Turning Against Capitalism – the Bernie Sanders "bounce"

Across generations, about half feel America's economic system works against them






Less Millennials have a favorable view of capitalism


Q3 Please tell me how strongly you agree or disagree with the following statement.


Q4 What change would ensure the highest earners pay their fair share?

Methodology



Online Survey



6 minutes



2,300 General Public Age 16+

The respondents were matched to a sampling frame on gender, age, race, education, party identification, ideology, and political interest. The frame was constructed by stratified sampling from the full 2010 American Community Survey (ACS) sample, and matched on other variables to the November 2010 Current Population Survey, and 2007 Pew Religious Life Survey. Each set of matched cases were weighted to its sampling frame using propensity scores. The matched cases and the frame were combined and a logistic regression was estimated for inclusion in the frame.
