METHODOLOGY

Nationwide Survey of Adults

- Telephone survey of 1,000 adults across the U.S.
- Interviews were conducted July 10 14, 2013.
- Survey conducted using live interviewers at a Computer-Assisted Telephone Interviewing (CATI) facility; 65% landline & 35% cell phone.
- Sample was generated using Random Digit Dialing (RDD), listassisted methodology. The sample was weighted to represent the US population using data from the Current Population Survey on age, gender, race, region, and education.
- Margin of error is +/- 3.0% at the 95% confidence level.


NATIONAL SURVEY RESULTS

Nearly Half the Country Supports SHIELD

After just hearing a brief description of the legislation with little context and no cost, almost half of the country supports the SHIELD Act

Would you favor or oppose Congress passing a law to install devices in the national power grid that would protect against an electromagnetic pulse, or EMP, event?




Strange Bedfellows Support SHIELD Act

Partisans on either side show high support for and a common purpose with the SHIELD Act, while Independents are initially split between support and opposition.

Would you favor or oppose Congress passing a law to install devices in the national power grid that would protect against an electromagnetic pulse, or EMP, event?





SHIELD Act Strong Across Region, Gender, Age


Men react more positively, while more women say they do not know. Younger voters are more in support of the legislation while seniors are closer to split.

Would you favor or oppose Congress passing a law to install devices in the national power grid that would protect against an electromagnetic pulse, or EMP, event?









Black Voters Most In Favor

Black voters support the SHIELD Act by 20-points. Those without children are slightly more in favor than parents; likewise, college graduates show a little more support.

Would you favor or oppose Congress passing a law to install devices in the national power grid that would protect against an electromagnetic pulse, or EMP, event?










Tri-Partisan Agreement on SHIELD Act





Overwhelming Support for SHIELD

No subgroup dips below 2/3rds support for the legislation after hearing more about it. Interestingly, the oldest and youngest swap from being the least in favor to the most (and vice-versa).




Childless, College Grads Support Most




A Majority Wants EMP Action Now

A majority of the country believe action on this issues ranks 8 or higher on a scale from 1 to 10, with 71% ranking it above a "5". The "Do-nothing Congress" label is redeemable by doing something big and consequential to protect the nation's infrastructure and security.

On a scale of 1 to 10, with 1 being the least important and 10 being the most, how important do you think it is that Congress take action to protect the country against an EMP event?




Security Moms Back SHIELD, joined by Seniors and non-Moms, too




African-American and Hispanic Voters Want Action
