Fred: As we discussed this morning, attached is a draft NYU Fellow Appointment agreement. I used a recent SAAG appointment agreement as a starting template for this. This may be more thorough and legalistic than you were thinking we might use. I wanted to start with the more thorough version, that looks more like an agreement. Let me know if you want to pare this down to bare essentials.

If we go with this version, I have embedded comments with questions about sections that I'm not sure are needed, at least perhaps not in this detail (like the entire HIPAA agreement attached as an exhibit).
