Methodology: The sample size for the survey is 1431 likely Democratic voters from Nevada, Iowa, New Hampshire, and South Carolina taken from a listed sample. 843 interviews were collected using automated telephone technology and 588 were collected using mobile web interviews. The margin of error is +/- 2.62%. Interviews were conducted November 10-11, 2018 by TPC Research. Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
