**ORDER GRANTING MOTION  
 TO COMPEL**

**Honor the Earth,**

This matter came before the Honorable Gretchen D. Thilmony, Judge of District Court, in the County of Becker, State of Minnesota upon Plaintiff's Motion to Compel discovery responses pursuant to Minnesota Rule of Civil Procedure 37.01.

NOW THEREFORE, having heard oral argument and duly considered the documents and proceedings herein, together with the applicable law, this Court makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Honor the Earth shall not destroy or delete any electronic data in its possession, including email, text messages, or Facebook data belonging to it or to its Executive Director, Winona LaDuke, that could contain relevant evidence in this matter unless and until this matter is fully resolved.
2. Within 14 days of this order, Campbell shall provide a step-by-step list of instructions to Honor the Earth through counsel explaining how to grant her access to email, Facebook, and text message data in the possession of Honor the Earth and its officers, directors, and employees, including the Facebook and email accounts of Executive Director Winona LaDuke.

3. Within 14 days of receiving these instructions from Campbell, Honor the Earth shall follow the instructions to provide Campbell access to this data or copies of this data.
4. Campbell shall search all accounts and data provided by Honor the Earth for documents responsive to her discovery requests.
5. After responsive documents are obtained, Campbell shall inform Honor the Earth that the searches are complete, return sole access of any accounts and data to Honor the Earth and its directors and officers, and delete any copies of non-responsive documents in her possession.
6. Campbell and her counsel shall not provide copies of any documents obtained from this order to any non-parties in this matter other than filing relevant documents in court and using them in official court proceedings.
7. Campbell shall Bates label and produce copies of all responsive documents she finds under this order to Honor the Earth.
8. Pursuant to Minn. R. Civ. P. 26.02(f)(2), if Honor the Earth claims any produced documents are subject to a privilege or protection as trial preparation material, it may notify Campbell of the claim and Campbell shall promptly return, sequester, or destroy the specified information and any copies she has and may not use or disclose the information until the claim is resolved. Any disagreements about whether documents are subject to privilege may be handled in the typical fashion described in Minn. R. Civ. P. 26.02(f)(2).
