1 FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS (FST'S):

2 **All tests were explained and demonstrated in English prior to their administration. Min was asked if he*
 3 *understood the instructions for each test prior to performing each test. Min was instructed to not begin a*
 4 *test until he related he understood how to perform the test. Min related he did not have any physical*
 5 *impairments that would preclude him from psychophysical tests.*

7 HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:

8 Min displayed a lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and an
 9 early onset of nystagmus prior to forty-five degrees in both eyes. I used my right index finger as the
 10 stimulus during the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test.

12 MODIFIED ROMBERG BALANCE:

13 Min estimated the passage of 30 seconds within a 25 second timespan. When asked how much time had
 14 passed, he stated, "30 seconds." During the entire test, Min displayed a circular sway of center
 15 approximately 2-3 inches off center.

17 ONE LEG STAND:

18 Min raised his left leg for this test. Min stopped the test at the passage of 30 seconds, after the count of
 19 1016. Min placed his lifted foot on the ground on the count of 1001 and swayed from side to side
 20 approximately 2-3 inches off center on the counts 1012-1016. During the entire test Min bent his left knee
 21 with the bottom of his foot parallel to the ground and raised both arms away from his body more than six
 22 inches for balance.

24 WALK AND TURN:

25 **Instructional Phase:** Min stepped offline, started too soon and placed the wrong foot forward during this
 26 phase.

28 **First nine Steps:** Min missed heel-to-toe contact on steps one and three-nine. The gaps between the steps he
 29 missed were more than ½ inch.

31 **Turn:** Min stopped momentarily after the turn and stepped offline.

33 **Second nine Steps:** Min missed heel to toe contact on steps four and six. The gaps between the steps he
 34 missed was more than ½ inch.

36 PRELIMINARY ALCOHOL SCREENING (PAS) DEVICE:

37 I read Min the PAS admonishment verbatim and he agreed to take this test. I administered this test using a
 38 calibrated PAS device and it detected the presence of ethyl alcohol with the results of **.150% BAC at 2247**
 39 **hours and .150% BAC at approximately 2250 hours.**

1 FIRST OBSERVATIONS:

2 On 05/02/2023, I was on duty in full California Highway Patrol (CHP) tan uniform, seated in the right front
3 seat of a fully marked CHP patrol vehicle #1501657 with my partner, Officer Blanchard, ID 22323, driving.
4 At approximately 2233 hours we were parked in a parking stall in the rear parking lot of the Capitol
5 Protection Section (CPS) CHP Area Office on 9th St. and R St. We observed a silver sedan, later identified
6 as a Toyota Camry, traveling southbound on 9th St., north of S St. I observed the Toyota come to a stop at
7 the intersection of S St., at a signaled red traffic light, and was traveling without headlights during the hours
8 of darkness, a violation of 24250 VC. We exited the CHP CPS Area Office parking lot, overtook the
9 vehicle, and positioned the patrol vehicle directly behind the Toyota. We observed the Toyota turn from the
10 #2 lane to the #1 lane of 9th St. The Toyota came to a stop at a signaled red traffic light, in the left turn lane,
11 at the intersection of Broadway, with the front tires of the vehicle past the fully marked white limit line. The
12 Toyota stopped at the signaled red traffic light for approximately 45 seconds, before proceeding into the
13 intersection at approximately 5-10 mph, as the traffic light remained red, a violation of 21453(a) VC.
14 Officer Blanchard initiated an enforcement stop for the violations, and the Toyota yielded to the right
15 shoulder of Broadway at Riverside Blvd.

16 OBSERVATIONS UPON ARRIVAL:

17 I exited the patrol vehicle and contacted the driver through an open front driver side window. I notified the
18 driver for the reason for the stop and requested his driver license, insurance and registration. The driver
19 related the vehicle was a State vehicle and presented me a California Driver License. The driver was
20 identified by the California Driver License as David Kunnghhee Min, with a date of birth of 03/05/1976, who
21 I recognized as California State Senator. I asked Min if he had consumed any alcohol that evening, and he
22 related he had two beers earlier in the evening. I observed Min's eyes were red and watery, he had
23 slow/slurred speech, and I detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from within the vehicle.
24
25 I instructed Min to exit the vehicle and follow me to the sidewalk off the south road edge of Broadway, so I
26 could evaluate his sobriety, and ensure he was able to continue to drive. Sgt. Pontius ID, 17801 and Acting
27 Sergeant Micheels ID, 18635 arrived on scene to assist with the stop. I asked Min a series of pre-field
28 sobriety test questions, and requested Min perform a series of pre-explained and demonstrated Field
29 Sobriety Tests (FST's) which he was unable to complete as explained and demonstrated.

32 ARREST AND BOOKING:

33 Based on the following, I formed the opinion Min had been driving a motor vehicle while under the
34 influence of an alcoholic beverage:

- 35 • My observations of Min's poor driving.
- 36 • Min exhibited signs of alcohol intoxication upon contact including unsteady gait, slow/slurred
37 speech, red and watery eyes, and the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person.
- 38 • Min's signs of impairment as he performed FST's.
- 39 • Min was seated in the driver's seat of the Toyota.
- 40 • Min's admission to consuming an alcoholic beverage prior to driving the Toyota.

1 **ARREST AND BOOKING: (continued)**

2 I placed Min under arrest at approximately 2251 hours for 23152(a) VC. I placed Min in handcuffs,
 3 adjusted for proper fit, and double locked the handcuffs. I performed a search incident to arrest, and I placed
 4 Min in the right rear passenger seat of the patrol vehicle, equipped with a prisoner barrier device. I notified
 5 Min of 23612 VC (Implied Consent) and his right to refuse, and he related he would submit to a chemical
 6 breath test. The Toyota was parked and locked at 1021 O St., Sacramento, CA, 95814 in the Swing Space
 7 parking garage by Sgt. Pontius with the permission of Min.

8
 9 Officer Blanchard and I transported Min to the CHP CPS Area Office to complete the Chemical breath Test.
 10 I observed Min did not eat, drink, smoke, burp, regurgitate, or vomit during the 15-minute observation
 11 period. Min completed the test with the results of 0.13% BAC at approximately 2317 hours and 0.14%
 12 BAC at approximately 2322 hours. Following the completion of the Chemical Breath Test, Officer
 13 Blanchard and I transported Min to Sacramento County Jail. Min was booked without further incident into
 14 Jail at approximately 0050 hours.

15
 16 **OTHER FACTUAL INFORMATION:**

17 All notes taken at the scene of this investigation were taken on notepad paper. All notes were destroyed
 18 upon completion of this report. All times were taken using my wristwatch.

19
 20 My patrol vehicle was equipped with a Wireless Mobile Video and Audio Recording System (WMVARS)
 21 which was utilized to record audio and visual events during the course of this DUI investigation.

22
 23 **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

24 I recommend a copy of this report be forwarded to the Sacramento County District Attorney's Office for
 25 review and prosecution of David Kunnghie Min for the following offense:

1 On May 2, 2023, I was on duty in full California Highway Patrol (CHP) uniform, driving a fully
 2 marked black and white CHP patrol vehicle (#1501657), and partnered with Officer Kummerfield
 3 (#21806), who was sitting in the right front passenger's seat. On this date, at approximately 2233
 4 hours, we were in the back parking lot of the CHP Capitol Protection Section (CPS) office, located
 5 at 1801 9th Street, in downtown Sacramento. While in the back we observed a silver Toyota
 6 Camry travelling southbound on 9th Street, approaching S Street in lane #2. As the Toyota
 7 passed our office parking lot, we observed the Toyota did not have any headlights activated
 8 during darkness, a violation of **California Vehicle Code Section 24250**.

9
 10 We exited the parking lot and began travelling southbound on 9th Street in lane #2 approaching
 11 the Toyota, which was still travelling with no headlights activated as it continued southbound on 9th
 12 Street. The Toyota came to a stop for a red light on 9th Street at the intersection of Broadway,
 13 waiting to turn left. As we were behind the Toyota, we observed the California Exempt license
 14 plate (**1286882**). The Toyota slowly began rolling forward past the limit line, in the left turn lane,
 15 waiting for the light to turn green. As the light was still red, the Toyota entered the intersection
 16 and began turning left to travel eastbound on Broadway, a violation of **California Vehicle Code**
 17 **Section 21453(a)**. We followed behind the Toyota and I activated the patrol vehicle's emergency
 18 code 3 lights to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. The Toyota yielded and came to a stop on the
 19 right shoulder of Broadway just west of Riverside Boulevard.

20
 21 Officer Kummerfield made a driver's side approach and contacted the driver, who was identified
 22 as (**David K. Min 03/05/1976**). It was at this time Officer Kummerfield and I realized the driver
 23 was Senator David Min. As Officer Kummerfield continued his investigation with Min, I contacted
 24 Acting Sergeant Micheels (#18635) and notified him of the situation.

25
 26 Officer Kummerfield ultimately arrested Min at 2251 hours for DUI. We transported Min to the
 27 CHP-CPS office and Officer Kummerfield administered the chemical breath test. Once the breath
 28 test was complete, we transported Min to Sacramento County Jail where he was booked into
 29 custody without further incident.

30
 31 This incident involved a CHP patrol vehicle equipped with a Wireless Mobile Video Recording
 32 System (WMVARS) which may or may not have captured all relevant information.
