AT APPROXIMATELY 1307 HOURS ON 10-14-04, WHILE ON REGULAR PATROL DUTY DISPLAYING MY BADGE OF OFFICE DRIVING A MARKED PATROL UNIT, I WAS DISPATCHED TO 1804 WYOMING, APT. 64, IN THE CITY OF LAS CRUCES, NEW MEXICO, COUNTY OF DONA ANA. WE WERE DISPATCHED TO A DOMESTIC IN PROGRESS CALL.

UPON ARRIVAL, I OVERHEARD ARGUING BETWEEN A MALE AND A FEMALE FROM INSIDE THE RESIDENCE FROM THE FRONT DOOR. I KNOCKED ON THE FRONT DOOR AND MADE CONTACT WITH THE MALE PARTY WHO WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS MR. GABRIEL VASQUEZ. MR. VASQUEZ SEEMED TO BE OUT OF BREATH AND SWEATY. OFFICER BACA (149) MADE CONTACT WITH THE FEMALE.

I ASKED MR. VASQUEZ WHAT WAS HAPPENING IN HIS APARTMENT AND HE ADVISED ME THAT HE WAS ARGUING WITH HIS GIRLFRIEND WHO WOULDN'T LEAVE HIS APARTMENT WHEN HE ASKED HER TO LEAVE EARLIER. HE TOLD ME THAT HE BROKE UP WITH HER JUST YESTERDAY AFTERNOON AND THAT EARLIER TODAY SHE HAD RETURNED AND BEGAN ARGUING WITH HIM AGAIN. HE SAID THAT SHE THEN TOOK HIS KEYS, LEFT THE APARTMENT, AND PROCEEDED TO MOVE HIS VEHICLE FROM ONE PARKING SPACE TO ANOTHER PARKING SPACE IN THE PARKING LOT OF THE APARTMENT COMPLEX. THAT IS WHEN MR. VASQUEZ RAN OUT OF HIS APARTMENT AND BEGAN TO CHASE THE VEHICLE DOWN TO STOP THE FEMALE. HE GOT THE FEMALE TO STOP THE VEHICLE AND RETAINED HIS KEYS FROM HER AND WALKED BACK TO HIS APARTMENT. HE SAID THAT SHE FOLLOWED HIM INTO HIS APARTMENT. ONCE THEY WERE IN HIS APARTMENT, THEY BEGAN ARGUING ONCE AGAIN AND HE HAD ASKED HER TO LEAVE AND SHE WOULDN'T. THAT IS WHEN HE STATED TO ME THAT HE DID TRY TO PUSH HER OUT OF THE FRONT DOOR OF HIS APARTMENT AND SHE FOUGHT BACK. SHE PLACED BOTH HANDS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE DOOR AND WOULD NOT LEAVE THE APARTMENT. MR. VASQUEZ SAID THAT HE HAD HIS HANDS ON HER SHOULDERS AND WAS TRYING TO PUSH HER OUT BUT SHE WOULD NOT LEAVE. THERE WERE NO VISIBLE MARKS ON THE FEMALE. THIS IS WHEN HE SAID THAT HE THEN CALLED THE POLICE BECAUSE HE DIDN'T WANT TO DO ANYTHING STUPID AND END UP GOING TO JAIL.

I ASKED MR. VASQUEZ IF HE WOULD MIND IF THE FEMALE WOULD GATHER HER BELONGINGS THAT SHE OWNS IN THE APARTMENT THAT WERE STILL IN THERE AND SHE WOULD BE ON HER WAY. HE SAID THAT WAS OKAY. THE FEMALE GATHERED HER BELONGINGS FROM THE APARTMENT WHILE MR. VASQUEZ WATCHED AND SHE LEFT. MR. VASQUEZ STATED THAT SHE DIDN'T LEAVE WITH ANYTHING THAT SHE SHOULDN'T HAVE. SHE TOOK ALL HER BELONGINGS AND HER BELONGINGS ONLY. THAT IS WHEN SHE LEFT. WE ADVISED MR. VASQUEZ THAT A REPORT WOULD BE MADE. PLEASE SEE OFFICER BACA (149) AND OFFICER BARELA'S (216) REPORTS FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.
