DECREE OF DIVORCE

The above-entitled action having come on regularly for trial on February 21, February 26, April 18, and May 16, 2024, before the above-entitled Court, Plaintiff/Counterdefendant, SUZANNE M. LEE ("SUSIE"), appearing in person and by and through her attorneys, RADFORD J. SMITH, ESQ., and GARIMA JAIN, ESQ., of SMITH JAIN STUTZMAN, and Defendant/Counterclaimant, DANIEL R. LEE ("DAN"), appearing in person and by and through his attorneys, ROBERT P. DICKERSON, ESQ., and SABRINA M. DOLSON, ESQ., of THE DICKERSON KARACSONYI LAW GROUP. This divorce action is at

1 issue upon Plaintiff's Complaint for Divorce, Defendant's Answer and
2 Counterclaim for Divorce, and Plaintiff's Reply to the Counterclaim. Both
3 parties having testified before the Court and stipulated to the Court's
4 entry of this Decree of Divorce; both parties having testified and
5 introduced evidence in support of the material allegations of their
6 respective pleadings, and both parties having waived the making, filing,
7 and service of Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and written Notice
8 of Entry of Judgment, and the giving of any and all notices required by law
9 or rules of the District Court. Therefore, the cause having been submitted
10 for decision and judgment, and the Court having before it all the files,
11 pleadings, and papers in the action, having heard all the testimony and
12 examined the evidence offered by each party, being fully apprised in the
13 premises and being satisfied that the action has been duly and regularly
14 commenced, and good cause appearing therefor, the Court finds and
15 concludes as follows.

16 The Court finds it has complete jurisdiction in the premises, both as
17 to the subject matter of this divorce action and as to the parties to this
18 action; that for more than six (6) weeks before the commencement of this
19 action, DAN and SUSIE were, have been, and are now actual bona fide
20 residents of the State of Nevada, actually and physically residing in Clark
21 County, Nevada, during all of said period of time; that the parties have no
22 minor children the issue of their marriage, no adopted minor children, and
23 SUSIE is not now pregnant; that on May 16, 2024, the parties appeared
24 before the Court for the fourth day of trial, and informed the Court that
25 they had reached a global settlement resolving all issues involved in this
26 divorce action, and each party testified and confirmed his or her
27 acceptance of the terms of the settlement their attorneys represented to
28 the Court and placed upon the record of the Court; thereafter, the parties

1 presented to the Court their written Marital Settlement Agreement,
2 effective as of May 16, 2024, setting out in writing the terms of their
3 settlement which are to be merged into this Decree of Divorce; the Court
4 further finds that the parties have resolved all issues relating or incident
5 to their marriage to each other;, and that the parties are entitled to an
6 absolute Decree of Divorce terminating their marriage on the grounds of
7 incompatibility.

8 Thus, with good cause appearing therefor, the Court hereby enters
9 the following Orders:

10 I. TERMINATION OF THE PARTIES' MARRIAGE

11 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the
12 bonds of matrimony heretofore and now existing between SUSIE and
13 DAN be dissolved, set aside, and forever held for naught, and the parties
14 therefore are awarded and decreed an absolute and final Decree of Divorce
15 terminating their marriage to each other, and each of them is hereby
16 restored to the status of a single, unmarried person.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
18 each party shall comply with the requirements of NRS 125.130(3) by
19 providing such party's social security number on a separate form to be
20 submitted to the Court and to the Division of Welfare and Supportive
21 Services of the Department of Health and Human Services ("Welfare
22 Division") as required by Nevada law. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that
23 the information each party is required to provide pursuant to NRS
24 125.130(3) shall be maintained by the Clerk of this Court and the Welfare
25 Division in a confidential manner, and such information shall not be made
26 part of the public records.

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1 II. MERGER OF MARITAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
3 the parties' Marital Settlement Agreement is effective as of May 16, 2024,
4 and the same hereby is ratified, confirmed, and approved by this Court.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, by this reference, the parties' Marital
6 Settlement Agreement *shall be merged and incorporated into and become*
7 *a part of this Decree of Divorce* to the same extent as if the Marital
8 Settlement Agreement, in its entirety, were set forth in this Decree in full.

9 A copy of the parties' Marital Settlement Agreement has been submitted
10 to the Court as a confidential document, and the same has been "left side"
11 filed in the Court's file as such a confidential document. IT IS FURTHER
12 ORDERED that the said Marital Settlement Agreement shall remain in
13 the Court's file as a sealed, confidential document, and the same shall not
14 be open to public inspection.

15 III. ADDITIONAL ORDERS

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
17 SUSIE and DAN be, and each hereby is directed to execute such quitclaim
18 deeds, stock transfers, certificates of title, deeds, bills of sale, or such other
19 documentation as may be required to transfer any right, title, or interest
20 he or she may have to the property of the party entitled thereto by virtue
21 of the division of assets as set forth in their Marital Settlement Agreement.
22 Should either party fail to execute any such documents, IT IS FURTHER
23 ORDERED that this Decree shall constitute a full and complete transfer
24 of the interest of one to the other as provided in their Marital Settlement
25 Agreement, or to otherwise effectuate any provision of this Decree.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
2 should either party sell any property in which the other has no right, title,
3 or interest by virtue of their Marital Settlement Agreement or this Decree,
4 that such other party will and shall sign any deed, contract, or other
5 instrument necessary to perfect title to any such property so conveyed.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
7 the parties shall pay their own respective attorneys' fees, experts' fees, and
8 costs incurred in this matter.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
10 SUSIE shall retain her married name, SUZANNE M. LEE.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
12 the Joint Preliminary Injunction previously entered in this matter is
13 DISSOLVED.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that
15 this matter will be kept in a confidential and sealed file in accordance with
16 the Order of this Court entered on December 19, 2021.
