SUBJECT: Determination on Disciplinary Action Board, Brig Gen Jeffrey W. Magram

1. In reference to the Board's findings and recommendation (that Brig Gen Jeffrey W. Magram be separated from State Active Duty effective 60 days from date of approval):

(Initial one of the following)

- a. Approve the board's recommendation to separate Brig Gen Magram from State Active Duty (full-time capacity). Under California Military and Veterans Code §2391, The Adjutant General (Acting) is directed to transfer Brig Gen Magram to the U.S. Air Force Retired Reserve (thereby removing him as an active drilling member and senior leader in the California Air National Guard).
- b. _____ Approve the board's recommendation to separate Brig Gen Magram from SAD (full-time capacity). Brig Gen Magram is hereby retained in the California Air National Guard as a traditional drilling member and officer.
- Disapprove the board's recommendation and retain Brig Gen Magram on State Active Duty and in the California Air National Guard.

¹ CMVC §239: "The Governor may assign, reassign, or fransfer commissioned officers and warrant officers from one organization to another or to the retired or the reserve list when deemed for the benefit of the California National Guard. The Governor may direct the Adjutant General to take any action under this section."
