FINAL JUDGMENT

On October 27, 2025, the court called this case to trial. Plaintiffs appeared in person and with counsel, Justin P. Nichols. Defendants appeared in person, *pro se*.

A petit jury was duly empaneled, sworn, and charged. After hearing all evidence and argument, the jury returned a verdict on October 30, 2025, and the court accepted same.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED, that for her intentional infliction of emotional distress and invasion of privacy, **ASHER VANN** shall have and recover judgment from and against **KIM T. COLE** in the amount of ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED NINTY-NINE THOUSAND & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,599,000.⁰⁰), accruing interest at a rate of 7.5% per annum, from the date of this judgment until paid.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED, that for her intentional infliction of emotional distress and invasion of privacy, **ASHER VANN** shall have and recover judgment from and against **SUMMER SMITH** in the amount of ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED NINTY-NINE THOUSAND & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,599,000.⁰⁰), accruing interest at a rate of 7.5% per annum, from the date of this judgment until paid.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, based on the court's order on May 21, 2025, Plaintiff **ASHER VANN** shall have and recover a judgment for attorney's fees from and against **KIM T. COLE** in the amount of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED &00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,500.00), accruing interest at a rate of 7.5% per annum, from the date of this judgment until paid.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, based on the court's orders on March 3, 2025, May 21, 2025, and August 26, 2025, Plaintiff **ASHER VANN** shall have and recover judgment for attorney's fees from and against **SUMMER SMITH** in the amount of SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$6,800.00), accruing interest at a rate of 7.5% per annum, from the date of this judgment until paid.

IT IS ORDERED that all writs and process necessary to carry this judgment into execution shall issue as allowed by law.

All costs are taxed to the party who incurred them. This is a final judgment and is appealable. All other relief not expressly granted herein is denied.
